

> Pronunciation is not just a question of acquiring knowledge, it's a physical skill that you need to practise regularly.







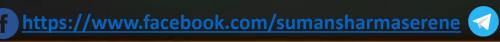
✓ Tongue twisters are a great way to practice and improve pronunciation and fluency.

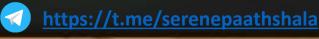






✓ They can also help to improve accents by using alliteration, which is the repetition of one sound.

2. Six ships ship six sheep when the sheep are asleep.



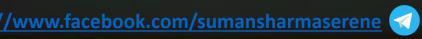

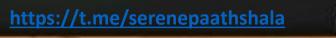

7. Watching out for bees when you play Frisbee is tricky but easy.









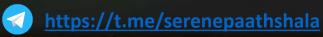

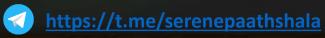

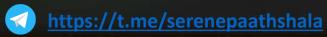
