Q:1 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **60 seconds**

The International Cricket Council (ICC) to start the Stop Clock Trial from the first West Indies Vs England T20I. The Stop Clock Trial will restrict the amount of time taken by bowlers between overs.

The Royal Bengal Tiger was captured by trap cameras of Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) for the first time at an altitude of 3640m. It was spotted inside the premises of Pangolakha Wildlife Sanctuary located at a tri junction of Sikkim, Bengal and Bhutan.
