## Answers and Solutions

Q:1 Correct answer is Option 3 i.e. Qatar. India lost to Qatar in the FIFA World Cup 2026 qualifier 0-3. India's record of 15 games unbeaten at home was shattered by the Qataris. Coach Igor Stimacs move to bench Goalkeeper Gurpreet Singh Sandhu backfired.

Q:2 Correct answer is Option 1 i.e. AWE. NASA is set to launch the Atmospheric Wave Experiment (AWE) aimed at studying the interactions between Terrestrial and Space weather. It will be attached to the exterior of the International Space Station and will study colourful bands of light in Earth's atmosphere called Airglow.

Q:3 Correct answer is Option 1 i.e. RISE. The AIM and NITI AAYOG launched a new accelerator called Rapid Innovation and Startup Expansion (RISE) to support Australian and Indian circular economy startups. Startups and small to mid sized Enterprises in India and Australia working on Circular technologies and solutions will benefit from it.

Q:4 Correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Mumbai. Union Minister of State for Textiles Srimati Dardhana Jardosh launched the E-registration portal of Sari Walkathon. The Sari Walkathon will be organised in Mumbai at MMRDA Ground.


