Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. collect. Let's have a look at the meaning of the given options:-

- **collect** to bring a number of things together.
- **dispose** get rid of by throwing away or giving or selling to someone else.
- flow- a steady, continuous movement of something/somebody.
- assemble to come together or bring somebody/something together in a group.

'Collect' which means 'to bring a number of things together' fits the context appropriately. Hence, the chosen option will be correct.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. a. English has two articles: the and a/an. 'The' is used to **refer to specific or particular nouns; a/an** is used to modify non-specific or non-particular **nouns**. We call **the** definite article and **a/an** the indefinite article.

The given statement is talking about the indefinite noun hence, 'A' will be the correct article here. Hence, the chosen option will be correct.

Q:3 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. submerges. Let's have a look at the meaning of the given options:-

- submerges- to go or make something go under water.
- separates to stop being together; to cause people or things to stop being together.
- **divides** to separate into different parts.
- ruins- to damage something so badly that it loses all its value, pleasure, etc.

'Submerges' which means 'to go or make something go under water' fits the context appropriately.

Hence, the chosen option will be correct.

Q:4 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. **so**.

"So" is used as a **coordinating conjunction** – (a word that joins two or more things, such as sentences or other words). When used in this way, it means 'therefore' or 'for that reason.'

For this meaning, "so" joins two complete sentences and shows the result of something in the second sentence.

The given statement shows the reason hence, 'so' will be the correct choice here.

Hence, the chosen option will be correct.

Q:5 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. water. Let's have a look at the meaning of the given options:-

- water- a large amount of water, especially the water in a lake, river or sea.
- **dam** a wall built across a river to hold back the water and form a lake (reservoir) behind
- land- the solid part of the surface of the earth.
- river- a large, natural flow of water that goes across land and into the sea.

The paragraph is talking about collecting water hence, the chosen option will be the correct choice. Hence, the chosen option will be correct.

Q:6 The correct answer is option 2 i.e. attached. Let's have a look at the meaning of the given options:-

- attached liking somebody/something very much.
- fond- like a person or thing, or liking doing something.
- held- to take somebody/something and keep him/her/it in your hand, etc.
- stuck- not able to move.

'Attached' which means 'liking somebody/something very much fits the context appropriately.

According to the saying 'attached' fits the given statement.

Hence, the chosen option will be correct.

'Kindly' which means 'in a kind or respectful way' fits the context appropriately.


Hence, the chosen option will be correct.
