## Answers and Solutions

**Q:1** The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **without**.

Since, communication is the act of thinking about what we wish to say before uttering words, of organizing the thoughts we wish others to hear and discuss so they will result in an appropriate action. Speaking just involves words.

The statement will use **without** in place of blank.

**Q:2** The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **because**.

The correct option will be the conjunction **because**.

**Because** will be used since, **we are focusing on the reason** that is not a good English speaker.

Example: She spoke quietly **because** *she didn't want Catherine to hear*.

**Q:3** The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **people**.

**People** will be used here in the place of blank.

Since the passage is about communication **people** will be the correct choice.

**Q:4** The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **at**.

**Correct preposition that will be used is 'at'.**

**"At"** is used when you are at the top, bottom or end of something; at a specific address; at a general location; and at a point.

We use **at** to describe a position or location seen as a point:

Example: A fisherman waited near his nets **at** the side of the quay. (position as a point)

There was no one **at** the information desk. (location as a point)

We use **at** to describe locations including firms, companies, workplaces and educational institutions:

Example: Did you once work **at** Intel?

The ancient manuscript, The Book of Kells, can be seen **at** Trinity College, Dublin.

Hence, **option 3** will be the correct answer.

**Q:5** The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **each**

**Each other** will be the correct phrase.

We use **each other** to show that each person in a group of two or more people does something to the others.

There is very little difference between *each other* and *one another* and we can normally use them in the same places. *Each other* is more common than *one another*.

**Option 3** i.e. **each** will be the correct choice.

**Q:6** The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **industrial**.

In the sentence itself it is mentioned 'consumer and industrial products'.

Hence, adjective '**industrial**' will be used for blank 5.

**Q:7** The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **such**.

The sentence is trying to give us the examples of home furnishing. Therefore, **such** will be used.

**'Such as'** is used to mean **'for example.'**

Hence, **option 3** is the correct answer.

**Q:8** The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **including**.

**Let's see the meaning of the following words:**

**Counting:** taking account of when reaching a total

**Wrapping:** paper or soft material used to cover or enclose something.

**Showing:** the way in which something is argued or represented.

**Including:** used for saying that a person or thing is part of a particular group or amount.

The sentence is saying what all comes under the consumer and industrial products, so **including** will be used.

Hence, **option 4** will be the correct answer.

**Q:9** The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **number**.

The sentence is talking about the consumer products hence, **numbers** will be used.

A large number of consumers products means a lot of consumer products.

Hence, **option 1** is the correct answer.

**Q:10** The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **are**.

Before the blank there is a plural noun, hence we will use the plural verb after it.
