Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. A-1-P, B-2-Q, C-3-

Explanation:

Statement Q elaborates on the social changes that accompanied the Industrial Revolution.
- Statement C talks about the crucial role played by the human immune system in fighting off diseases. Statement 3 provides details on how the immune system works to identify and eliminate harmful invaders. Statement R further explains how the immune system can malfunction, leading to various health conditions.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. A-1, B-2, C-3.

When combined, the statements form a coherent paragraph that talks about different developments, including the company's new line of eco-friendly products, the government's initiative to promote digital literacy in rural areas, and the university's grant to conduct research on sustainable agriculture practices. The option that correctly pairs the statements in Column I and Column II is A-1, B-2, C-3.

Q:3 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. A-2, B-3, C-1. When combined, the statements form a coherent paragraph that talks about the company's new policy on diversity training, the marketing team's proposed ad campaign focusing on social responsibility, and the CEO's plans to expand operations into three new countries.

The option that correctly pairs the statements in Column I and Column II is A-2, B-3, and C-1.

Q:4 The correct answer is option 5 i.e. A-2, B-1, C-3.

- When we combine statement A with statement 2, we get a logical and meaningful sentence that highlights the seriousness of climate change as a major challenge facing the planet.
- Similarly, when we combine statement B with statement 1, we get a sentence that explains how the rising temperature is causing ice caps to melt and leading to rising sea levels.
- Finally, when we combine statement C with statement 3, we get a sentence that emphasizes the importance of preserving biodiversity in the face of climate change.

Therefore, the correct combination is A-2, B-1, C-3.

Q:5 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. A-1-P, B-2-Q, C-3-
