

control a situation rather than just responding to it after it has happened.

The word that fits as its synonym is "Farseeing" which means having shrewd judgment and an ability to predict and plan for future eventualities.

Q:4 The correct answer is option 4; i.e. Diminish

The given question suggests finding the correct antonym (a word with the opposite meaning) of the given word.

The word "accumulated" means gather together or acquire an increasing number or quantity.

The only word that seems to be its antonym is "Diminish" which means to make or become less. Hence, option 4 is correct.


