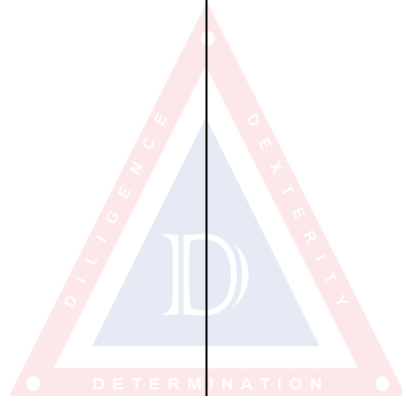

Active voice- Subject + has/have + v3 + object + other words.

Passive voice- Object + has/have + been + v3 + by + subject + other words.

Q:2 The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **No one was ever abused by her.**

Active voice- Subject + v2 + object + other words.

Passive voice- Object + was/were + v3 + by + subject + other words.

Q:3 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **Superstitions are still believed in by many villagers.**

Active voice- Subject + v1/v5 + object + other words.

Passive voice- Object + is/am/are + v3 + by + subject + other words.

The verb '**Believe**' is followed by the preposition '**In**'.

Q:4 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **It is time for dinner to be served.**

Active voice- It + is + time + to + v1 + object.

Passive voice- It + is + time + for + object + to be + Past Participle.
