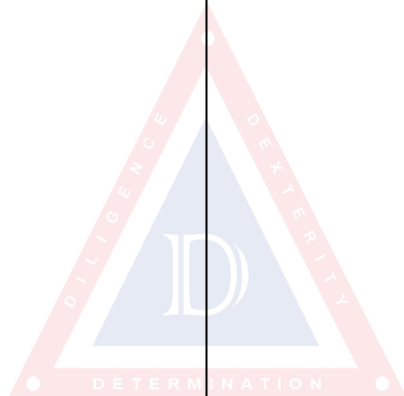

## Answers and Solutions

**Q:1** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **A large pizza was being eaten by him.**

Given sentence: He was eating a large pizza. (Active voice)

The subjects and the object interchange their positions.

Structure of passive voice: was + being + V3

Sentence in passive voice: A large pizza was being eaten by him.

**Q:2** The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **Everybody in the family is going to admire the new bride.**

Given sentence: The new bride is going to be admired by everyone in the family. (Passive voice)

Passive voice: Objective case of subject + V2 + Subjective case of object

Active voice: Subject + V1 + Object

Sentence in active voice: Everybody in the family is going to admire the new bride.

**Q:3** The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Have you uploaded the assignment?**

**The grammatical rule being followed to convert the sentence into an active voice is:**

The subject of the sentence is changed to the doer of the action, 'you'.

The verb tense is changed to present simple tense to match the subject, 'did'.

The passive verb 'been uploaded' is changed to the active verb form 'upload'.

**Thus, the correct form of active voice is:**

Have you uploaded the assignment?

**Q:4** The correct answer in **option 1** i.e. **Eight villages in the state were visited by the central team to assess the damage to the crops.**

The structure of active to passive voice for past indefinite i.e. simple past tense follows the structure:

**Active voice** - Subject + V2 + object + other words.

**Passive voice**- Object + was/were + v3 + by + subject + other words.

As the chosen option follows this structure it will be the correct answer.

**Q:5** The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **The flood victims were rescued by the disaster management team**

**Active voice** - Subject + V2 + object + other words.

**Passive voice**- Object + was/were + v3 + subject + other words.

As the chosen option follows this structure it will be the correct answer.

**Q:6** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **The doorbell rang when the hall was being dusted by the maid.**

Given sentence: The maid was dusting the hall when the doorbell rang. (Active voice)

Active voice: Subject + was/were + V1 + ing + Object

Passive voice: Object + was/were + being + V3 + by + Subject

The given sentence is in the past tense.

Sentence in passive voice: The doorbell rang when the hall was being dusted by the maid.

**Q:7** The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Experimenting with different cuisines is liked by Anant.**

Given sentence: Anant likes experimenting with different cuisines. (Active voice)

The given sentence is in the simple present tense.

Structure of active voice: Subject + V1 form + s/es

Structure of passive voice: Object + is/am/are + 3rd form + Subject

Sentence in passive voice: Experimenting with different cuisines is liked by Anant.

**Q:8** The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **The instructions were being read out by the invigilator.**

**Q:9** The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **Tea is grown in Darjeeling**

Tense	Active voice	Passive voice
<b>Simple present</b>	Does/Do	Is/am/are
<b>Present Continues</b>	am/is/are	Am/is/are+ being
<b>Present Perfect</b>	has/have	has been/have been

<b>Simple past</b>	Did	Was/were
<b>Past Continues</b>	was/were	was/were+ being
<b>Past Perfect</b>	Had	Had been
<b>Simple Future</b>	will	will be
<b>Future Perfect</b>	will have	will have been

**Q:10** The correct answer is option 2 i.e. **Let the box be picked up.**

The given sentence is in **active voice** and we need to change it into **passive voice**.

**General Rule:-**

**Active voice-** Main verb + object + other words.

**Passive voice-** Let + object + be + past participle + other words.

The **subject** and **object** of the active voice become **object** and **subject** in the passive voice respectively.

The chosen option follows this structure hence, it will be the correct answer.
