Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Pithy.

Vapid : Lifeless, dull or banal.

Pithy : vigorous and expressive, Concise and meaningful.

Insipid : Unappetizingly, flavorless.

Dead : No longer living.

Dull : Lacking the ability to cut easily; not sharp.

As the chosen option best expresses the opposite of the given word, it is correct.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 2 i.e. Suppress.

Faunt: display (something) ostentatiously, especially in order to provoke envy or admiration or to show defiance.

Suppress: forcibly put an end to.

Impenitent: not feeling regret over one's sins

Indict: to accuse of wrongdoing, charge

Lectern: a stand with a slanted top used to support a bible.

As the chosen option best expresses the antonym of the given word, it is correct.

Indignant- feeling or showing anger or annoyance at what is perceived as unfair treatment.

Annoyed- feeling angry or slightly angry.
