

Dockyard- an area with docks and equipment for repairing and maintaining ships.

Sojurn- a temporary stay.

wigwam-a dome-shaped hut or tent made by fastening mats, skins, or bark over a framework of poles (as used formerly by some North American Indian peoples).

hut-a small, simple, single-storey house or shelter. As the chosen option best expresses the meaning of the given group of words it will be correct.
