Q:1 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Quick**.

Let's see meaning behind the given words:

- **Quick:** moving fast or doing something in a short time.
- **Slow:** not quick or fast.
- **Gradual:** taking place or progressing slowly or by degrees.

The chosen option is giving similar meaning, hence it is correct.

Q:2 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Committed**.

Let's see meaning behind the given words:

- **Dedicated:** devoted to a task or purpose.
- **Dreary:** depressingly dull and bleak or repetitive.
- **Boring:** not interesting; tedious.
- **Committed:** pledged or bound to a certain course or policy; dedicated.
- **Tedious:** too long, slow, or dull; tiresome or monotonous.

Hence, the chosen option, which is giving the similar meaning to the given word, is correct.

- **Definite:** fixed, certain, or clear.
- **Specific:** relating to one thing and not others.
- **Precise:** exact and accurate.

- Retell**- tell again or differently.
- Reset**- set again or differently.
