

Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **Inadequate**. In the given question, we need to select the SYNONYM of the given word.

A word that has the similar meaning of another word is its synonym.

Let's have a look at the meaning of the underlined word:-

Meagre means 'deficient in amount or quality or extent'.

For example: - They were forced to give their meagre earnings.

Synonym of meagre is 'inadequate' which means 'lacking the quality or quantity required; insufficient for a purpose.'

The chosen option expresses a similar meaning of the given word hence, it will be the correct choice.

Q:2 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Gall**. In the given question, we need to select

the SYNONYM of the given word.

A word that has the similar meaning of another word is its synonym.

Let's have a look at the meaning of the underlined word:-

Impudence means 'the trait of being rude and impertinent; inclined to take liberties'.

Synonym of impudence is 'gall' which means 'bold and impudent behaviour'.

The chosen option expresses a similar meaning of the given word hence, it will be the correct choice.

Q:3 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. Frivolous.

The theme of the question is to find the word that is the synonym (a word with the same meaning) of the highlighted word.

The meaning of the given word '**Trivial**' means lacking importance.

The word to be representing the synonym is 'Frivolous' because it has the same meaning as the word given in the question.

Hence, the chosen option is correct.

Frivolous: lacking importance

Eventful: having great meaning or lasting effect.

Unfrivolous: as in serious, earnest.

Meaningful: clearly conveying a special meaning.

Q:4 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Taken with**. In the given question, we need to select the **SYNONYM** of the given word.

A word that has the similar meaning of another word is its synonym.

Let's have a look at the meaning of the underlined word:-

Infatuated means 'possessed with an intense but short-lived passion or admiration for someone.'.

Synonym of **Infatuated** is '**Taken with**' which means 'you are very interested in something/someone or attracted to them'.

The chosen option expresses a similar meaning of the given word hence, it will be the correct choice.

Q:5 The correct answer is **option 4 i.e. Visualise.** In the given question, we need to select the **SYNONYM** of the given word.

A word that has the similar meaning of another word is its synonym.

Let's have a look at the meaning of the underlined word:-

Envision means 'imagine as a future possibility; visualize'.

Synonym of Envision is 'Visualise' which means form a mental picture of something that is invisible or abstract'.

The chosen option expresses a similar meaning of the given word hence, it will be the correct choice.

Q:6 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. rebelliously. In the given question, we need to select the SYNONYM of the given word. A word that has the similar meaning of another word is its synonym. Let's have a look at the meaning of the underlined word:-

Defiantly means 'in a rebellious manner'.

word is its synonym.


Let's have a look at the meaning of the underlined word:-
