Q:1 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Belief.

Conviction: A strong belief or opinion.

Approach: A way of dealing with something or a

method of doing things.

Suspicion: A feeling that something is bad or

wrong.

Doubt: A feeling of uncertainty or lack of belief.

Belief: A strong feeling that something is true, even without proof. It's having confidence in the truth or

existence of something.

In this context, 'conviction' refers to a strong belief, so 'belief' is the most appropriate synonym.

Q:2 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Richness.

Poverty means not having enough money or resources to live comfortably.

Richness means having an abundance of money or resources.

Loft is a specific type of room or space in a building, often under the roof. It doesn't relate to living comfortably or having money.

Hardship means facing difficulties or challenges.

In the sentence, the word 'prosperity' suggests that the person and their family are living well and comfortably.

The closest synonym to 'prosperity' from the options is 'richness,' as it also means having a lot of resources and living comfortably.

Q:3 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. Catch.

Seize: To take hold of something forcibly or suddenly.

Filter: To pass through a device or substance to remove impurities

End: The final part of something; the termination of an event or process.

Ocean: A large, continuous body of salt water that covers a significant portion of the Earth's surface.

Catch: To hold onto something that is moving; to

capture or grab.

The word closest in meaning to 'Seize' is 'Catch,' as both involve taking hold of something, whether it's an opportunity or a physical object.

Q:4 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. a significant. In the context of the sentence, the word 'important' is best represented by the synonym 'a significant,' as it conveys the idea that the issue is notable or carries significance.

Q:5 The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. Receive.

Earn: To gain or deserve something through effort

or action.

Receive: To accept or take something.

Lose: To be deprived of, to no longer have

possession of something.

Accord: To give or grant someone power, status, or recognition, often as a result of their actions or

qualities.

Surrender: To yield or give up control or possession as a result of force, or a decision. Hence, the chosen option is the correct answer.

Q:6 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. encasement.

Cocoon: A cocoon is a silky case spun by the larvae of some insects for protection during the pupal stage. In a metaphorical sense, it refers to a protective or enveloping structure or environment.

Encasement: An encasement is a covering or case that encloses or protects something.

Bundle: A bundle is a collection of things tied or wrapped together.

Fabric: Fabric refers to a material produced by weaving or knitting textile fibers.

Downy: 'Downy' refers to something soft, fluffy, or covered with down (fine, soft feathers).

The most appropriate synonym to substitute the underlined word 'cocoon' in the given sentence is 'encasement.'

Q:7 The correct answer is Unskillful i.e. Option 4.

Awkward: Lacking skill and resulting in discomfort or embarrassment.

Dormant: In a state of rest or inactivity.

Asleep: In a state of sleep; not awake.

Clever: It refers to someone who is smart and has good problem-solving abilities.

Unskillful: Lacking skill or proficiency; not skillful.
