Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **Enlarge**.

Let's have a look at the meaning of the given options-

- **Magnify**: make (something) appear larger than it is.
- **Enlarge**: make or become larger or more extensive.
- **Withdraw**: remove or take away (something) from a particular place or position.
- **Shrink**: become or make smaller in size or amount.
- **Decrease**: make or become smaller or fewer in size, amount, intensity, or degree.

Q:2 The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **Plentiful**.

Let's have a look at the meaning of the given options-

- **Abundant**: existing in large quantities.
- **Plentiful**: existing in or yielding great quantities.
- **Necessary**: needed to be done, achieved, or present; essential.
- **Available**: able to be used or obtained.
- **Latest**: of most recent date.

- **Paradise**- an ideal or idyllic place or state.
- **Efficient**- (of a system or machine) achieving maximum productivity with minimum wasted effort or expense.

The meaning of the given words is:

- **Gradual**: taking place or progressing slowly or by degrees.
- **Expedite**: make (an action or process) happen sooner or be accomplished more quickly.
- **Excite**: very enthusiastic and eager.
- **Slow**: moving or operating, or designed to do so, only at a low speed; not quick or fast.
- **Terrain**: a stretch of land, especially with regard to its physical features.

Thus, the most appropriate synonym of '**Gradual**' is '**Slow**'.

Q:7 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Hidden**.

- **Conceal**- not allow to be seen; hide.
- **Ambiguous**-open to more than one interpretation; not having one obvious meaning.
- **Hidden**- kept out of sight; concealed.
- **Insight**- the capacity to gain an accurate and deep understanding of someone or something.
- **Upturn**-an improvement or upward trend, especially in economic conditions or someone's fortunes.

- **Chafe**- (with reference to a part of the body) make or become sore by rubbing against something.
- **Irritate**- make (someone) annoyed or a little angry.

- **Joy**- a feeling of great pleasure and happiness.

- **Elated**- make someone ecstatically happy.
- **Dishearten**- having lost determination or confidence; dispirited.
- **Cheered**- shout for joy or in praise or encouragement.
- **Encourage**- give support, confidence, or hope to (someone).
- **Inspired**- of extraordinary quality, as if arising from some external creative impulse.

Q:10 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Composite**.

- **Hybrid**- the offspring of two plants or animals of different species or varieties, such as a mule.
- **Composite**- made up of several parts or elements.
- **Homogeneous**- made up of parts that are all of the same types.
- **Pure**- not mixed with anything else.
- **Love**- a strong feeling that you have when you like somebody/something very much.
