

Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Delhi**.

1. Iltutmish, also called Shams al-Dīn Iltutmish was the third and the greatest Delhi Sultan of the so-called Slave Dynasty.

2. He strengthened and expanded the Muslim empire in northern India and moved the capital to Delhi, where he built the great victory tower, the Qutab Minar.

Q:2 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Agra**.

Akbar's seat of Government was Agra.

He was the third Mughal emperor, who reigned from 1556 to 1605.

Akbar succeeded his father, Humayun.

After conquering Chittor, Akbar decided to shift his capital from Agra to Sikri Ridge.

Q:3 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **6th December, 2017**.

President Trump formally recognized Jerusalem as the capital of Israel, reversing nearly seven decades of American foreign policy and setting in motion a plan to move the United States Embassy from Tel Aviv to the fiercely contested Holy City.

In taking this action, President Trump fulfilled a major campaign promise of his and many previous Presidential candidates.

The Trump Administration is fully coordinated in supporting this historic action by the President, and has engaged broadly with both our Congressional and international partners on this issue.

Q:6 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Gandhinagar**.

Gandhinagar is the capital of Gujarat. It is named after the father of the nation Mahatma Gandhi.

Gandhinagar is situated on the banks of the river Sabarmati.

In 1960, Bombay State was split into two different states, Gujarat and Maharashtra. Ahmedabad became the capital of Gujarat and remained so from 1960 to 1970.

A new capital city was to be built and in 1965, the construction work of Gandhinagar began.

The capital was shifted to Gandhinagar in 1971.

H.K. Mewada and Prakash Mapte designed the new capital.

It is India's second properly planned city after Chandigarh.

Q:7 The correct answer is **option 4** i.e. **Represents Unity**.

A) The Lion Capital is clearly Buddhist and Mauryan in origin and thus probably symbolizes the spread of Dharma, and perhaps the extent of the Maurya Empire in all directions, or four parts of the empire.

B) The lion references the Buddha, formerly Shakyamuni, a member of the Shakya (lion) clan.

C) The lion is also a symbol of royalty and leadership and may also represent the Buddhist king Ashoka who ordered these columns.

A chakra (wheel) was originally mounted above the lions.

Q:8 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Pataliputra**.

The capital of the Mauryan empire was Pataliputra.

Modern name: Patna

Pataliputra is at the confluence of two rivers, the Son and the Ganges.

Chandragupta Maurya was the founder of the Mauryan Empire.

Brihadratha was the last ruler of the Mauryan Empire.

The capital of Kashi Mahajanapada was Varanasi.

Kashi Mahajanapada was situated to the west of Vajji Mahajanapada.
