**Q:1** The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **Yen**.

Japan:

Capital: Tokyo

1 Yen = 0.56 Indian Rupee.

National language: Japanese

Other currencies

Renminbi: China

Euro: currency of 19 of the 27-member states of the European Union.

**Q:2** The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **15**.

Contemporary Currency notes have 15 languages on the panel which appears on the reverse of the note.

The language panel on Indian rupee banknotes display the denomination of the note in 15 of the 22 official languages of India.

They are from top to bottom – Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Kashmiri, Konkani, Malayalam, Marathi, Nepali, Oriya, Punjabi, Sanskrit, Tamil, Telugu, Urdu.

**Q:3** The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **Rand**

The currency of South Africa is Rand. The rand was introduced in the Union of South Africa in 1961, three months before the country declared itself a republic.

**Q:4** The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. **Nakfa**.

Nakfa is the currency of Eritrea and was introduced on 15 November 1998. The currency takes its name from the Eritrean town of Nakfa, site of the first major victory of the Eritrean War of Independence.

The currency of Argentina is the **Argentine peso**. The Argentine peso precedes the amount in the
