Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. Binsar WS A tiger was spotted for the first time in the Binsar Wildlife Sanctuary, Uttarakhand. The Sanctuary covers an area of 46 square kilometres and is located at an altitude of 2250 metres. It is a rare and significant event as Tigers are usually found at low altitudes.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. Chandel.

- The Chandela rulers are best known for the construction of the Khajuraho Group of Monuments, a collection of stunning Hindu and Jain temples.
- The temples are renowned for their intricate and elaborate erotic sculptures, as well as exquisite architectural details.
- The temples were built between the 9th and 11th centuries and are now a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Q:3 The correct answer is option 2 i.e. Chattarpur.

- The Khajuraho Group of Monuments is a UNESCO World Heritage Site located in the town of Khajuraho in the Chhatarpur District of Madhya Pradesh, India.
- The temples were built between 950 and 1050 AD by the Chandela dynasty.
- The Khajuraho temples are divided into three groups: Western Group, Eastern Group, and Southern Group.

- The 'Mahakaal' temple likely refers to the Mahakaleshwar Temple, is located in Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, India.

- The Konark Sun temple is situated in the state of Odisha.
- This temple is attributed to king Narasimhadeva-I of the Eastern Ganga dynasty, and represents a classical illustration of Great Kalinga architecture.
- The Konark temple was declared 'World' Heritage' site by UNESCO in 1984.

- The Thissur Pooram festival is celebrated annually on the Pooram day, the day when the moon rises rom the Pooram star, in tha Malayalam calendar month of Medan, and is celebrated in the Vadakkunathan temple.
- The Thissur Pooram is a vibrant and colorful festival and is also known as the mother of all poorams in Kerala.
- The festival is a dazzling display of rich cultural traditions and customs, including caparisoned elephants, colorful parasols, and percussion music.

- Jagannath Puri is the epicentre for the Rath Yatra in Odisha. The Puri Jagannath Rath Yatra is one of the most celebrated and revered religions events in India.
- This Jagannath Puri Temple is an important Hindu temple dedicated to Jagannath, a form of Vishnu, which is one of the Trinity of supreme divinity in Hinduism.
- King Indradyumna of Avanti has built the main temple of Jagannath at Puri. The temple is one of the 108 Abhimana Kshethram of Vaishnavite tradition.
