Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **DST**.

Union Minister of State Dr Jitendra Singh launched the software application 'Dashboard' portal of the Ministry of Science and Technology for real time prompt and effective Parliament business including Parliament Questions, Acts of Parliament and Gazette notifications of Government of India as well as Cabinet Notes. The foundation stone of the new auditorium cum Guest House complex in the premises of Technology Bhavan which is the headquarters of Department of Science and Technology was also laid down.

UNICEF is headquartered in New York.

The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) was created by the United Nations General Assembly on December 11, 1946.

Earlier it was called United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund.

Polish physician Ludwik Roshman played a major role in forming UNICEF.

The main objective of creating it was to provide food and health care in emergency situations to children and mothers in the countries devastated by World War II.

In the 1950s, UNICEF's scope was expanded to address the long-term needs of children and women in developing countries.

In 1953, it became a permanent part of the United Nations and the words 'International' and 'Emergency' were removed from the name of this organization.

Its name is now United Nations Children's Fund but the original acronym 'UNICEF' has been retained.

The institute has since grown into a multi-disciplinary oceanographic research institute of international repute.

The principal focus of research has been on observing and understanding special oceanographic characteristics of the Indian Ocean.

The major research areas include the four traditional branches of oceanography - biological, chemical, geological/geophysical, and physical as well as ocean engineering, marine instrumentation and marine archaeology.
