Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Switzerland**

Founded on 29th April 1961. Its precursor organisation was the Conservation Foundation. Its original name was World Wildlife Fund. WWF Headquarters – Gland, Switzerland.

Q:2 The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **HPCL**

- All the other given companies have their headquarters in Kolkata except HPCL.
- HPCL was established in 1974.
- HPCL is an Indian state owned oil and natural gas company with its headquarters at Mumbai, Maharashtra.

- India won the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) Vice Presidency and Strategic Management Board (SMB) Chair for the 2023-25 term.
- India's representative Vimal Mahendru, a member of the Indian National Committee of the IEC and various technical committees of the Bureau of Indian Standards were elected as IEC vice president.

- CSB Bank Limited (erstwhile Catholic Syrian Bank Limited) is an Indian private sector bank with its headquarters at Thrissur, Kerala, India. The bank has a network of over 703 branches and more than 515 ATMs across India.

- The International Organization of Securities Commissions is an association of organizations that regulate the world's securities and futures markets.
- It develops, implements, and promotes adherence to internationally recognized standards for securities regulation.
- IOSCO has members from over 100 countries.
- It has a permanent headquarters in Madrid, Spain.

- The World Customs Organization is an intergovernmental organization headquartered in Brussels, Belgium.
- It is the only intergovernmental organization exclusively focused on Customs matters.
- It was established as the Customs Co-operation Council in 1952 to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of customs administrations worldwide.

Q:10 The correct answer is **Option 4** i.e. **Hyderabad**

- NMDC Limited, (National Mineral Development Corporation), is a government-owned mineral producer.
- It is under the administrative control of the Ministry of Steel.
- It was incorporated in 1958 as a Government of India fully owned public enterprise with its headquarters in Hyderabad, Telangana.
