## **Answers and Solutions**

Q:1 The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **NITI AAYOG** Union Minister Bhupender Yadav launched a NITI AAYOG report titled "A Green and Sustainable Growth Agenda for the Economy' in New Delhi. Ambassador of Brazil to India Kenneth Felix also participated in the launch event.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. South Africa The South African Department of Water and Sanitation released a Report titled "Blue Drop National Report 2023". The report stated that almost half of the drinking water was deemed microbiologically unsafe for consumption. The decline in drinking water quality has been experienced in South Africa since 2014.

Q:3 The correct answer is **option 3** i.e. 20
A new report titled "Africa Regional Overview of Food Security and Nutrition 2023" was released by combined efforts of various UN agencies. The report stated that 20% of the African Population experienced undernourishment in 2022. The report was jointly released by FAO, AUC, ECA and WFP.

Q:4 The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **CEEW**The Council on Energy, Environment and Water (CEEW) released a report titled The Emissions Divide Report 2023. The report highlights the differences in Carbon emissions between Developing and Developed nations.

The report was released in the Philippines. The report stated that Road traffic deaths fell slightly to 1.19 million per year.

21000 deaths per year happen due to lung cancer
caused by Radon. It becomes the second leading
cause of death in the United States. Radon is a
radioactive gas formed when Uranium, Thorium or
Radium break down in Rocks, Soil and
Groundwater.
