Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **1900**

Cricket was also included as an Olympic sport at the 1900 Paris Games, where Great Britain defeated France to win the gold medal. This was the only appearance of cricket at the Summer Olympics.

Q:2 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Badminton**

- Unnati Hooda is an Indian badminton player from Haryana.
- She is the youngest Indian to win a BWF Super 100 title

Q:3 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Shooting**

- Abhinav Shaw recently won gold in ISSF Junior World Championships 2023 took place at Changwon Shooting Range, South Korea from July 16 to 24.
- This year's third edition of the competition featured 90 proficient Indian shooters competing in pistol, rifle, and shotgun categories for the under-21 age group in an effort to win medals.
- India's won a total of 17 medals, including six gold, six silver, and five bronze at the ISSF Junior World Championships 2023.

She is the first Indian footballer to play in the UEFA Women's Champions League.
