## Answers and Solutions

**Q:1** The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **Badminton**

- Unnati Hooda is an Indian badminton player from Haryana.
- She is the youngest Indian to win a BWF Super 100 title

**Q:2** The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Shooting**

- Abhinav Shaw recently won gold in ISSF Junior World Championships 2023 took place at Changwon Shooting Range, South Korea from July 16 to 24.
- This year's third edition of the competition featured 90 proficient Indian shooters competing in pistol, rifle, and shotgun categories for the under-21 age group in an effort to win medals.
- India's won a total of 17 medals, including six gold, six silver, and five bronze at the ISSF Junior World Championships 2023.

**Q:3** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Chess**

Pallathur Venkatachalam Nandhidhaa is an Indian chess player from the state of Tamilnadu, who holds the FIDE titles of Woman Grandmaster and Woman International Master. She is the 17th Woman Grandmaster of India.

**Q:4** The correct answer is **Option 5** i.e. **Boxing**

Lovlina Borgohain is an Indian boxer. She won a bronze medal at the 2020 Olympic Games in the women's welterweight event, becoming only the third Indian boxer to win a medal at the Olympics.

**Q:5** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Football**

Manisha Kalyan (born 27 November 2001) is an Indian professional footballer who plays as a forward for Cypriot First Division club Apollon and the India women's national team. She won the 2020–21 AIFF Women's Emerging Footballer of the Year and the 2022–23 AIFF Women's Player of the Year awards. She is the first Indian footballer to play in the UEFA Women's Champions League.

**Q:6** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Weightlifting**

- Ragala Venkat Rahul (born 16 March 1997) is an Indian weightlifter who won gold medal in the men's 85 kg weight class at the 2018 Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast, Australia.
- At the 2014 Summer Youth Olympics in Nanjing, he won the silver medal in the 77 kg category. This was India's first ever medal in weightlifting at the Youth Olympics.

**Q:7** The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Tennis**

- Lleyton Hewitt, a two-time Grand Slam champion and former world number one, was inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame.
- Lleyton Hewitt has won 2 Grand Slam titles in his career.
- He won the 2001 US Open and 2002 Wimbledon titles and helped Australia capture the Davis Cup in 1999 and 2003.

**Q:8** The correct answer is **Option 5** i.e. **Hockey**

- Manpreet Singh Pawar is an Indian field hockey player.
- He is the captain of the Indian men's national field hockey team since May 2017.
- He led the Indian field hockey team to the bronze medal at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics.

**Q:9** The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Swimming**

- Sajjan Prakash will always be remembered as the first Indian swimmer to win a direct qualification to the Olympics. At the 2021 Sette Colli trophy in Rome, Sajjan Prakash clocked 1:56.38 seconds - a new national record - in the men's 200m butterfly event.
- It is the second straight time that India's most experienced swimmer has bagged the coveted trophy after his success in the 2015 National Games in Kerala.

**Q:10** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Boxing**

- Amit Panghal is an Indian boxer and Indian Army Junior Commissioned Officer.
- He is from Rohtak, Haryana.
- He won silver medal at the 2019 AIBA World Boxing Championships in the Flyweight division. Panghal won a gold medal at the 2018 Asian Games. Amit Panghal has received top seeding in the 52 kg category.
