Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **option 1** i.e. **Faizabad**.

- The Faizabad International Sports Stadium is known as Bhim Rao Ambedkar International Sports Stadium.
- Different types of sports, like cricket, football, athletics, swimming, karate, badminton, table tennis, etc can be played in the stadium and it can host more than 30,000 spectators.

Q:2 The correct answer is **option 2** i.e. **Rani Rampal**. Stadium named after hockey star Rani Rampal, first woman to get this honour.

- A) Indian team's star hockey player Rani Rampal has become the first woman in the sport to have a stadium named after her, in Rae Bareilly.

- The stadium itself has a rich sporting history and has been a hub for various sporting events, with a primary focus on hockey and cricket.
- Gwalior, as a city, has a deep-rooted association with sports and has produced many notable athletes over the years.
- Roop Singh Stadium is one of the prominent sporting venues in the region, and it has witnessed numerous cricket matches and hockey tournaments.
- It's not only a place for sports but also holds cultural and historical significance, making it a destination of interest for both sports enthusiasts and tourists.

- The final match of the Indian Premier League (IPL) season 9 in 2016 was played in the stadium of the State of Karnataka.
- The final match took place at the M. Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bangalore, which is one of the well-known cricket stadiums in India and serves as the home ground for the Royal Challengers Bangalore team in the IPL.

Q:6 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Bengaluru**

- M . Chinnaswamy Stadium is a cricket stadium in Bengaluru, Karnataka, India. It is owned by the Government of Karnataka and operated by the Karnataka State Cricket Association (KSCA).
- It regularly hosts Test, ODI, T20I and first-class cricket matches as well as musical, cultural events.
- The stadium is the home ground of the Karnataka state cricket team, Karnataka women's cricket team and IPL franchise Royal Challengers Bangalore.
- Earlier known as the Karnataka State Cricket Association Stadium, it was later renamed to pay tribute to Mangalam Chinnaswami Mudaliar, a lawyer from Mandya and a founding member of the Mysore State Cricket Association.

- He served the KSCA for four decades and was also the President of the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) from 1977 to 1980. The latter's National Cricket Academy was also located on the same stadium premises.

The Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of the International Cricket Stadium in Varanasi. The modern international cricket stadium will be developed in Ganjari, Varanasi for a cost of About Rs 450 crores and spread over 30 acres. The design of the International stadium in Kashi is dedicated to Lord Mahadev.

- It was because of Baichung, the game football became popular in Sikkim.
