Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. Binsar WS A tiger was spotted for the first time in the Binsar Wildlife Sanctuary, Uttarakhand. The Sanctuary covers an area of 46 square kilometres and is located at an altitude of 2250 metres. It is a rare and significant event as Tigers are usually found at low altitudes.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 3 i.e. Shipra. The 'Mahakaal' temple likely refers to the Mahakaleshwar Temple, is located in Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, India.

It is one of the most famous and revered Hindu temples dedicated to Lord Shiva which is known for its lingam (a representation of Lord Shiva).

Munneswaram Hindu kovil is one of the important Pancha Ishwara Hindu kovil in Sri Lanka located in Chilaw of Puttalam District, North Western province of Sri Lanka.

The deity of this temple is Lord Muneshwaraan, who is a Hindu God, worshipped as a family deity in most Shaivite families in India.

This temple has endured in this neighborhood for more than 100 years & managed by a clan for nearly 7 generations.

One of the elegant sights associated with the temple festivals of Kerala is the 'Ezhara Ponnana' procession held during the annual festival at Ettumanoor Sree Mahadeva Temple in Kottayam.

The Thissur Pooram festival is celebrated annually on the Pooram day, the day when the moon rises rom the Pooram star, in tha Malayalam calendar month of Medan, and is celebrated in the Vadakkunathan temple.

The Thissur Pooram is a vibrant and colorful festival and is also known as the mother of all poorams in Kerala.

The festival is a dazzling display of rich cultural traditions and customs, including caparisoned elephants, colorful parasols, and percussion music.

Q:7 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Jagannath Puri Temple

Jagannath Puri is the epicentre for the Rath Yatra in Odisha. The Puri Jagannath Rath Yatra is one of the most celebrated and revered religions events

This Jagannath Puri Temple is an important Hindu temple dedicated to Jagannath, a form of Vishnu, which is one of the Trinity of supreme divinity in Hinduism.

King Indradyumna of Avanti has built the main temple of Jagannath at Puri. The temple is one of the 108 Abhimana Kshethram of Vaishnavite tradition.
