The 'Abhijit Muhurat' Window:

The 84-second period is part of the larger 'Abhijit Muhurat,' a 48-minute window considered extremely sacred in Hindu astrology. Starting at 12:16 PM and ending at 12:59 PM on the day of the inauguration, this auspicious time frame adds an extra layer of sanctity to the consecration ceremony.

- Dec 6, 1992: The 16th-century Babri mosque demolished by 'kar sevaks.'
- Nov 9, 2019: In a historic verdict, Supreme Court grants entire 2.77 acres of disputed land in Ayodhya to deity Ram Lalla.
- Feb 5, 2020: PM Modi announced the formation of a trust to construct a Ram temple in Ayodhya.
- Aug 5, 2020: PM Modi laid the foundation of the Ram temple.

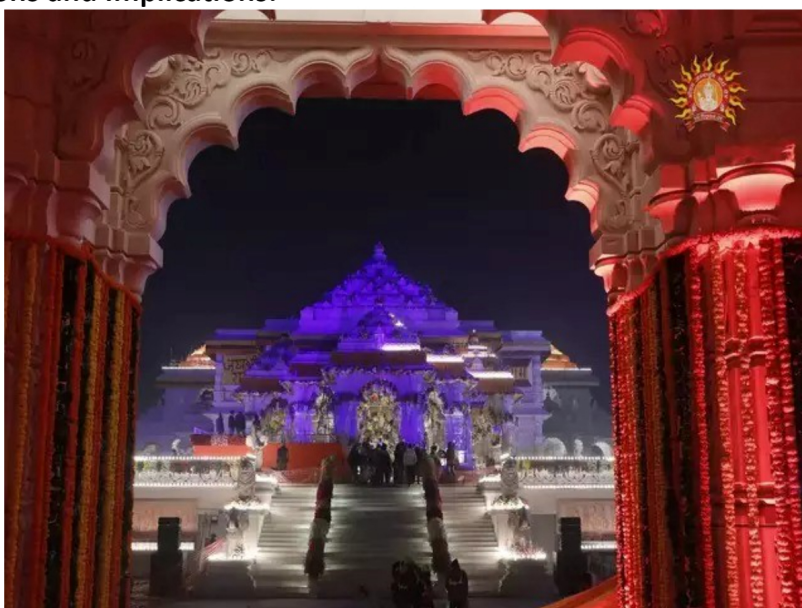
