


Q:2 Four pairs of numbers have been given, out of which three are alike in some manner, while one is different. Choose out the odd one.





## **Answers and Solutions**

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 3, i.e. C.

The logic which follows here is:

In all the figures there are two lines, except in figure C, which has three lines in it.

Hence, Option 3 is the correct answer.

Q:2 The correct answer is option 1 i.e. 18:306

Let us see all the options:

$$(18)^2 - 18 = 306$$

$$(25)^2 + 25 = 650$$

$$(23)^2 + 23 = 552$$

$$(13)^2 + 13 = 182$$

Q:3 The correct answer is option 4 i.e. D6V14

Let us see all the options:

- 1) A5Z15 A is the first letter from left and Z is the first letter from right in English alphabetical order; 5 + 15 = 20
- 2) C9X11 C is the third letter from left and X is the third letter from right in English alphabetical order; 9 + 11 = 20
- 3) F12U8 F is the sixth letter from left and U is the sixth letter from the right in English alphabetical order; 12 + 8 = 20
- 4) D6V14 **D** is the fourth letter from left, whereas **V** is the fifth letter from the right in English alphabetical order; 6 + 14 = 20

Hence option 4 is the odd one

Q:4 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. B

Except for Figure B, all other figures are divided in 4 parts.

Hence, the correct answer is B.

Q:5 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. BCDF

1) 
$$LMOQ - L + 1 = M, M + 2 = O, O + 2 = Q$$

3) 
$$VWYA - V + 1 = W, W + 2 = Y, Y + 2 = A$$

Hence the correct answer is BCDF.

Q:6 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. HATCH

Logic: The word will have 2 vowels

Except for HATCH rest, all words are consisting 2 vowels one at the second position and another one at the last.

So, HATCH is odd from the above options.

Hence, the correct answer is HATCH.

Q:7 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. 2.

Except in Figure (2), in all other figures the design or shape has been divided vertically.

Hence, the correct answer is 2.

Q:8 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. 9, 78 **Loaic**:

Second number = Square of the first number - 5

$$8^2 = 64 - 5 = 59$$

$$6^2 = 36 - 5 = 31$$

$$7^2 = 49 - 5 = 44$$

Clearly, Option 3 is the odd one.

Hence, the correct answer is 9, 78.

Q:9 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Identified

Anonymous: (used about a person) whose name is not known or made public

Innominate: not named or classified

Incognito: hiding your real name and identity (especially if you are famous and do not want to be recognized)

Anonymous, Innominate, and Incognito are synonyms.

They mean something/someone that is hidden or not known.

On the other hand, Identified means something/someone that is known.

Hence, the correct answer is **Identified**.


**Q:10** The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **Marble** Except for Marble, all others are precious stones.

So, Marble is the odd one out.

Hence, the correct answer is Marble.


