Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. Priyanka Chopra Jonas

Hear yourself : Prem Rawat :: Monsoon : Sahitya Akademi :: Unfinished : ?

Hear Yourself is written by Prem Rawat.

Monsoon is written by Sahitya Akademi.

Similarly, Unfinished is written by Priyanka Chopra Jonas.

Hence, the correct answer is **Priyanka Chopra Jonas.**

Q:2 The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. Australia

Golden Eagle : Albania :: Blue Crane : South Africa :: Emu : ?

The Golden Eagle is the national bird of Albania.
The Blue Crane is the national bird of South Africa.
Similarly, Emu is the national bird of Australia.
Hence, the correct answer is **Australia**.

Q:3 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Brazil.

'Holi' is a famous festival of 'India' in the same way 'La Tomatina' is a festival of 'Brazil'.

Hence, Brazil is the correct answer.

Q:4 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Newspaper : Journalist.**

'Author' writes 'Books' in the same way 'Journalist' writes about 'News' in the newspaper.

Hence, **Newspaper**: **Journalist** is the correct answer.

Q:5 The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. Proof

Researchers use theories to explain and understand phenomena.

Similarly,

Courts use proof to solve cases and help people on the basis of evidence.

Hence, the correct answer is proof.

Q:6 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **Released** Here, Develop is a synonym for Evolve.

Similarly, Released is the synonym for Exempt. Liable is the antonym of Exempt. Guilty and Charge are not related to Exempt. Hence, the correct answer is **Option 2**.

Q:7 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Chess

B. Sai Praneeth : Badminton :: Pentala Harikrishna : ?

Famous sports personalities : sports

B. Sai Praneeth is a Badminton player.

Similarly,

Pentala Harikrishna is a Chess player.

Hence, Chess is the correct answer.

Q:8 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **New Zealand** Washington. D. C. is the capital of the United States

Similarly,

Wellington is the capital of New Zealand. Hence, the correct answer is **New Zealand**.

Q:9 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Key: Basket A group of sheep is a flock.

Similarly,

A group of keys is a bunch, not a basket. Hence, the correct answer is **Key: Bunch**.

Note:

A group of mountains is a range.
A group of experts is a panel.
A group of lions is a troop.

Q:10 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Hole Lion lives in a den.

Similarly, the snake lives in a hole in the ground. Hence, the correct answer is **Hole.**
