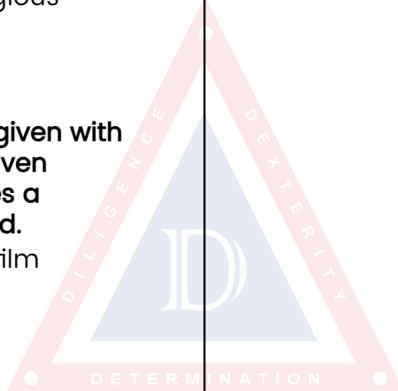

## Answers and Solutions

**Q:1** The correct answer is **Option 5 i.e. None of these.**

The given question is based on vocabulary observation i.e. reading the passage carefully and finding the similar/opposite word as per instructions.

The 'lawsuit' means a claim or dispute brought to a law court for adjudication.

Among the given options all words (case, litigations, proceedings, and trial are synonyms of the word 'lawsuit').

Hence, the chosen option is correct.

**Q:2** The correct answer is **Option 3 i.e. The court's observations came during a hearing on the plea of the central government, filed through the Delhi Police, seeking an injunction against the proposed tractor march or any other kind of protest by farmers that seeks to disrupt the scatter and celebrations of Republic Day on January 26.**

The given question is based on vocabulary observation i.e. reading the passage carefully and finding the similar/opposite word as per instructions.

Gather means an assembly/meeting held for a specific purpose. Among the given options 'C' contains the opposite meaning of gathering i.e. 'scatter'.

Convocation/muster and assembly are synonyms of gathering.

Hence, the chosen option is correct.

**Q:3** The correct answer is **Option 4 i.e. There is one strong group in the country of those which considers itself different and "above it all" from all this. But the authenticity of this enlightened section is doubtful when seen against reality. It can be said that the country's present benefit is a result of the dubiousness of this section.**

The given question is based on vocabulary observation i.e. reading the passage carefully and finding the similar/opposite word as per instructions.

Predicament means 'a difficult/awkward situation'. Among the given options 'C' is correct as this sentence contains the opposite meaning of the word 'predicament' that is 'benefit'.

Difficult/awkward situations and muddle are the synonyms of the word 'predicament'.

Hence, the chosen option is correct.

**Q:4** The correct answer is **option 2 i.e. The majority held that the devotees of Lord Ayyappa do not constitute a united religious denomination.**

The given query is to identify the sentence which expresses a meaning opposite to the given sentence, with the highlighted word replaced by a word of the opposite meaning.

The bold word 'separate' means disconnected .

Synonyms: Free, independent, isolated

Antonyms: United, connected, associated

Clearly option 2 united expresses the opposite meaning of the given sentence.

Hence option 2 is correct.

**Q:5** The correct answer is **option 3 i.e. Disliked.**

The purpose of the given query is about finding an antonym (a word that contains the opposite meaning) of the given word.

The meaning of the word 'Relish' means to enjoy or praise.

Synonym of the word: Enjoy, Adore, Appreciate

Antonyms of the word: Dislike

Clearly, option 3 represents the meaning which is opposite to the given word.

Hence, the correct answer is option 3.
