

Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. The teacher ordered students to write what was written on the board.

As the reported speech is an **Imperative sentence**, we need to make changes according to this

There will be a change in the reporting verb 'said' into 'ordered'.

The Preposition **'to'** will be added in the sentence to show a connection between the Reported Speech and reporting verb.

The tense of the reported speech will be changed to **Simple Past Tense**.

As all the rules are followed by the chosen option, it will be correct.

Thus, the required indirect form would be:

The teacher ordered students to write what was written on the board.

As the reported speech is in 'Assertive sentence' we need to make changes according to this.
