Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **4 March 2008**

- It was inaugurated on 4 March 2008 as the home ground of Indian Premier League franchise Mumbai Indians.
- In 2008 and 2010, it served as the venue for the inaugural season finals. The stadium held a lot of games in the 2022 season.

Q:2 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **10th**

- Bharat Ratna Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ekana Cricket Stadium is an international cricket stadium in Lucknow.
- The stadium was renamed as Bharat Ratna Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ekana Cricket Stadium which was previously known as Ekana Cricket Stadium to honour the 10th Prime Minister of India.

Q:3 The correct answer is **Option 1** i.e. **2010**

The Indian government first built Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium to house the 1982 Asian Games' sporting competitions and festivities. The 1989 Asian Athletic Championships were also held there. For the 2010 Commonwealth Games, the stadium underwent extensive renovations and modernization, serving as the venue for all track and field competitions as well as the opening and closing ceremonies.

Q:4 The correct answer is **Option 3** i.e. **1864**

- Kolkata, India's Eden Gardens is home to an international cricket ground. It was built in 1864 and is the third-biggest cricket stadium in the globe, as well as the oldest and largest in India.
- It was established in 1864.

Q:5 The correct answer is **Option 2** i.e. **2015**

- It is the largest stadium in the world.
- The Sardar Patel Stadium was built on the same land as the Narendra Modi Stadium and stood there until it was demolished in 2015.
