

Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Only II and III are appropriate

Statements I and IV are not the appropriate course of action because stopping all the traffic on the national highway is not possible and can cause many difficulties, while statement IV is also not appropriate because some people do not take the sign board seriously.

Only Statements II and III are the most effective course of action for road safety view.

Hence, the correct answer is **Only II and III are** appropriate.

Q:2 The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. A

Statement I is the cause and statement II is the effect. Because of the dangerous effect of the tsunami and the safety of the people government released the advisory.

Hence, the correct answer is A.

Q:3 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Only argument II is strong

There are many states in India where women are being suppressed and are not provided with an equal chance to grow in society. Empowerment of women is a major area of concern and a great task for the state government to deal with in those societies.

Hence the correct answer is **Only argument II is strong**.

Q:4 The correct answer is Option 4 i.e. Both I and II follow.

The statement talks about energy conservation and its impact on the environment.

Conclusion I: If we reduce the amount of energy we use, we can reduce the degradation of fossil fuels to some extent. As the main source of energy is non-renewable fossil fuels by decreasing their use we can have them for a longer period of time. Hence, conclusion I follow.

Conclusion II: By reducing the use of the energy we can help clean up the environment. Hence, conclusion II also follows.

Thus, Both I and II follow.

Q:5 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e Statement II is the cause and statement I is its effect.

As the district administration has conducted an extensive training program for the workers involved in the literacy drive, therefore, literacy in the district has been increasing for the last four years.

Hence the correct answer is **Statement II is the** cause and statement I is its effect
