### Answers and Solutions

Q:1 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. Only II follows Inference I: Nothing about the students of country X is mentioned so, they may or may not have quality research exposure compared to country Y. So, it does not follow.

Inference II: This inference follows as it is mentioned that it will help students to interact with scientists and students will get to know more important things and clear their doubts as well. Hence, option 2 is the correct answer.

### Q:2 The correct answer is Option 1 i.e. Only conclusion I follows.

#### Conclusion:

I. Training the local people will help to provide first aid to the patient on time. True (as it is mentioned that first responders of road accidents will be trained by experts and providing first-aid is the first and foremost part of treating any person) II. The number of accidents will be reduced. False (Training the local people to treat the wounded people is mentioned not about the reduction in the number of accidents.)

Hence, only conclusion I follows.

### Q:3 The correct answer is Option 3 i.e. both I and II follow.

## Conclusion:

I. It will improve access to the government securities market for retail investors. True (as it is given that the RBI Retail Direct Scheme will help them to directly invest in securities issued by the government.

II. It will be a time-saving initiative. **True** (as direct investment in government securities can be made and there will be a single point of reference for customers to file their complaints, submit the documents, track their status, and provide feedback. This will save time.)

Hence, both I and II follow.

Q:4 The correct answer is Option 3 i.e. Only I follows

Assumption I is valid because the government's announcement of the new policy implies a need to promote renewable energy sources, which can be seen as a step towards reducing dependence on non-renewable energy sources.

Assumption II is not necessarily valid, as it is possible that the new policy may not lead to a significant increase in the use of renewable energy sources. While the policy aims to promote renewable energy sources, its effectiveness in increasing their use depends on several factors such as the level of implementation and uptake by the public and industry.

Therefore, only assumption I is valid in this case. Hence, the correct answer is Only I follows.

### Q:5 The correct answer is Option 2 i.e. If both I and Il are strong.

Arguments I and II are strong as this move affects the creativity of the film badly

TV reality shows are the creative pursuits presented by the filmmaker and of course, this will significantly damage the mind and kill the time of the young generation.
